

I am pleased to present the **Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Annual Report of Sponsored Activity** at East Carolina University.

Sponsored programs are activities funded by external organizations, including federal and state agencies, non-profit organizations, and business enterprises. They typically include a scope of work or a set of specific aims; specific period of performance; requirement for separate budgeting and accounting of funds; financial and technical reporting to the sponsor; and requirement of compliance with federal and state regulations. Types of sponsored activities in which ECU engages include research and development, instruction, public service, clinical trials, and student support.

The Division of Research, Economic Development and Engagement (REDE), through its Offices of Sponsored Programs and Grants & Contracts,

administers ECU's sponsored projects. The Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) supports faculty and staff in proposal preparation and submission and in award negotiation and acceptance. The Office of Grants & Contracts (OGC) provides post-award accounting and administration services, including financial reporting and audit coordination. Both offices strive to provide the highest quality of service to faculty and staff while ensuring appropriate stewardship of sponsor funds, protection of the University's reputation, and enhancement of the public's trust in the national research enterprise.

In this report, for the first time, expenditure data from OGC and proposal and award data from OSP are combined in a single annual report of sponsored program activity. Also for the first time, this report includes ECU Physicians Practice Plan/Brody School of Medicine (ECUP/BSOM) contracts with community healthcare facilities for medical staffing. These contracts are administered by ECUP/BSOM rather than REDE, but they otherwise are managed in much the same way sponsored programs are managed. The awards support our mission of providing health care in North Carolina and illustrate the significant commitment of ECU to serving the citizens of the Region.

Sponsored activity is on a growth trajectory after the negative impact of the recession of 2007-2009. In fact, total sponsored project awards received in FY2015-2016 are at an all-time high of almost \$50 million. ECUP/BSOM contracts total \$53+ million, bringing the total of external funds awarded to over \$100 million. These awards are expected to translate into an increase in grant and contract expenditures in the next few years, and research expenditures is one of the indices that determine state funding for the university.

REDE thanks all the faculty and staff who pursued external funding in Fiscal Year 2015-2016 in the furtherance of ECU's mission, and we congratulate those who were awarded funds by external agencies. We also would like to express our appreciation to members of the University Research Council and our partners in Health Sciences and Academic Affairs that have informed and led research administration at ECU. Together, we have implemented a number of major initiatives directed at streamlining operations, facilitating pursuit of extramural funding, managing awards, and ensure continued growth of the sponsored programs portfolio into the future.

Interpreting the Data

There are three traditional ways of reporting on an institution's sponsored program activity: proposals submitted, awards received, and award expenditures. The following explanations of these data types will assist in correct interpretation of this annual report.

Expenditures

Expenditure reports provide the most accurate measure of sponsored activity. Actual expenditures during a defined time period (fiscal year) provides a consistent basis on which to compare sponsored program activity over a period of years, between University units, and with other universities. Expenditures are reported by fiscal year, regardless of the starting and ending dates of the awards. Expenditures rarely equal awards in a sponsored programs portfolio. In some cases, the University does not expend all the funds committed for each each award. Fee for service agreements, especially clinical trials when enrollment targets are not met, can have expenditures well below award amount. Thus, expenditure data are the most reliable for trend analysis and internal and external comparisons.

The Office of Grants & Contracts oversees the financial management of grants and contracts in the Banner financial system and provides the annual expenditure data.

Awards

The award amount is the sponsor's funding obligation to the University; the University may spend less than or up to that amount during the award period but may not spend more. Awards reported in a fiscal year period include new funds for a new project, supplemental funds for an existing project, aditional funds for a project extension, and annual incremental funding received for a multi-year project. Because award reports include both single-year and multi-year award totals, they are not a reliable predictor of expenditures for the coming year. Although not the most accurate means of quantifying sponsored project activity, awards are often used by external entities as the proxy for expenditures when reporting on the sponsored projects portfolio and when comparing institutions.

The Office of Sponsored Programs receives awards on behalf of the University and captures award data in the Research Administration Management System and electronic Submission (RAMSeS) database.

Proposals

Proposal data reports include all new funds requested, whether for a single year or a multi-year project, during the fiscal year. The request may be in a new proposal for a new project period, in a new proposal for repeat of a previously funded project, in a supplemental funding request for the same project period, or in an additional funding request for a project extension. Because the request for funds may occur in an earlier year than receipt of award, calculating proposal success rates by comparing proposals and awards and using proposal data is not appropriate.

The Office of Sponsored Programs approves all proposals for submission on behalf of the University and captures proposal data in the Research Administration Management System and electronic Submission (RAMSeS) database.

Reporting by PI/PD Home Unit and by Administrative Unit

In past years, proposal and award data were presented by Administrative Unit, which may be an institute or center. In Fiscal Year 2015-2016, proposal and award data are presented by the Principal Investigator/Project Director (PI/PD) home unit. Reporting by PI/PD home department will become the default in future years. However, to preserve trend analysis, reporting by Administrative Unit has been continued in FY 15-16 and will continue for several more years. A new Affiliated Centers report page has been included to identify proposal activity and award receipt for projects that include institute or center involvement.

2015-2016 Expenditures by Category













