Re: T34 MARC Eligibility

East Carolina University (ECU) has reviewed relevant NIH policy and data at NIH RePORTER and determined that all the components of the University have received over \$7.5 million dollars in RPGs - Non SBIR/STTR per year over the past three fiscal years. The average over the last 3 years is \$9,387,241, which qualifies East Carolina University as a baccalaureate degree-granting research-intensive institution and is therefore eligible to apply to the T34 Maximizing Access to Research Careers program.
